



## Ground Manager

At each venue, the Tenant Club shall supply a Ground Manager for each match who will be responsible for monitoring crowd behaviour and bringing any inappropriate conduct to the attention of club officials. The Ground Manager will also be the point of contact for any queries or concerns about the venue. A Ground Manager must wear the League approved “identification apparel” = bib.

### Duties

- If you are rostered on the top oval you are responsible for the top oval area and top oval change rooms – same with bottom oval.
- Please ask people who are inside the fence line (other than the coaching crew) to position themselves on the OUTSIDE side of the fence
- With your blue Ground Manager bib on – people will ask you for directions, location of toilets etc
- Please check the change rooms after the previous teams leave & collect rubbish
- Please do a rubbish pick up around the ground
- Gloves are located in the kitchenette on top oval & cafe at bottom oval.
- Crowd management - any issues please contact your Team Manager who will inform relevant authorities
- Last Ground Manager of the day (from each oval) must collect lost property and bring to canteen to lost property box
- Last Ground Manager of the day (from each oval) must take down goal post covers and top oval bunker covers and put away in the timekeeper box between the two ovals
